John has a Master's Degree in Communications (Photography and Visual Arts) with post-graduate work at the University of Pittsburgh and New England School of Photography. He is a former managing editor of "Video Systems" magazine, an international trade publication serving the visual arts profession.

John is an internationally recognized photographer and taught degree programs in photography at Robert Morris University and Allegheny College in Pittsburgh and is a regular instructor and juror in the professional photographer's continuous learning environment.

Throughout his career, he has enjoyed the challenges of photojournalism, advertising, portrait and event photography; always striving to capture that special moment; deliver a stirring story or elicit a heart-felt response. John's images can be seen in advertising and editorial content for Holland America Cruise Lines, Tabor Academy, "Sailing Magazine," the Bermuda Sloop Foundation and numerous others.
